Lifetime: One-time dues of \$500	An individual who meets the criteria for NAL membership and has paid one-time dues of \$500.	--a JSC badge (issued annually) --receive NAL and NAL-JSC information, invitations and newsletters, --access to the NAL-JSC Library, and --eligible to serve as an Officer and/or Director. --Lifetime Member status is acknowledged by a letter from the National and the JSC Chapter President of the NAL. --Membership card states "LIFETIME Member"
Benefactor: One-time dues of \$1,000	An individual who meets the criteria for NAL membership and has paid one-time dues of \$1,000.	--a JSC badge (issued annually) --receive NAL and NAL-JSC information, invitations and newsletters, --access to the NAL-JSC Library, and --eligible to serve as an Officer and/or Director. --Benefactor Member status is acknowledged by a letter from the National and the JSC Chapter President of the NAL. --Membership card states "Benefactor Member"
